

GIRLS

Girls' hair must be neat and tidy at all times.

- Girls may wear white, black, navy, dark green elastic bands/ ribbons; Girls with light hair may only wear white headbands, girls with dark hair only black/ navy headbands; Only plain dark hair clips, without any patterns, decorations or mixed colours are allowed.
- If a girl's hair touches her blazer or shirt collar, it must be tied up in a ponytail or plaited.
- Ponytails must be neat and in the middle of the back of the head, not on top or on the side of the head.
- The fringe must not reach the eyebrows. The fringe must be at least 10mm above the eyebrows or be tied down at the side of the head.
- 'Cornrows' and braids (with or without extensions) are allowed as long as they are 5mm in diameter. 'Cornrows' or braids must be parallel with each other from the forehead to the neck. No patterns in the 'cornrows' are allowed.
- Every braid or 'cornrow' must be the same length and the same colour as the learner's natural hair colour.
- Braids or 'cornrows' that are shorter than the collar, must be out of the face; and those longer than the collar must also be tied back.
- No extraordinary or funky/ punk hairstyles will be allowed. Hair must not be cut so short that the skin is visible.
- Hair may not be dyed or bleached and must be neat and clean. Hair products like gel or other styling products may NOT be used.
- Nails must not be longer than the fingertips and only neutral nail polish will be allowed.
- No make-up will be allowed during school attendance or when representing the school whether in school uniform or not.
- Any transgression of the above-mentioned rules mentioned will result in demerit points on the school's demerit point system and/ or a "uniform suspension" until such time that the indiscretion has been corrected.
- No wiggs, false eyelashes or built-up nails will be allowed.
- Civvy days: all above mentioned rules apply

BOYS

Boys must always wear their hair neat and according to the school norms as set out as follows:

- When the upper part of the body and head is held upright the lowest part of the hair should not touch the collar.
- At the back of the head, from the neck upwards the hair must gradually thicken and follow the natural contour of the head.
- The hair along the sides of the head must not touch the ears.
- The fringe should not touch the eyebrows.
- Hair should not be cut so short that the skin is visible.
- No unusual or funky hairstyles, for example 'comb-overs, schoolboy cuts and mohawks, will be allowed.
- No lines or patterns may be cut into hair or eyebrows.
- Hair may not be dyed or bleached and must be neat and clean. Hair products like gel or other styling products may NOT be used.
- No beards or moustaches will be allowed.
- Sideburns must not be lower than the middle of the ear.
- Boys who have to shave, must do so regularly and may not attend or represent the school without having shaved.
- Any transgression of the above-mentioned rules will result in demerit points on the school's demerit point system and/ or a "uniform suspension" until such time that the indiscretion has been corrected.
